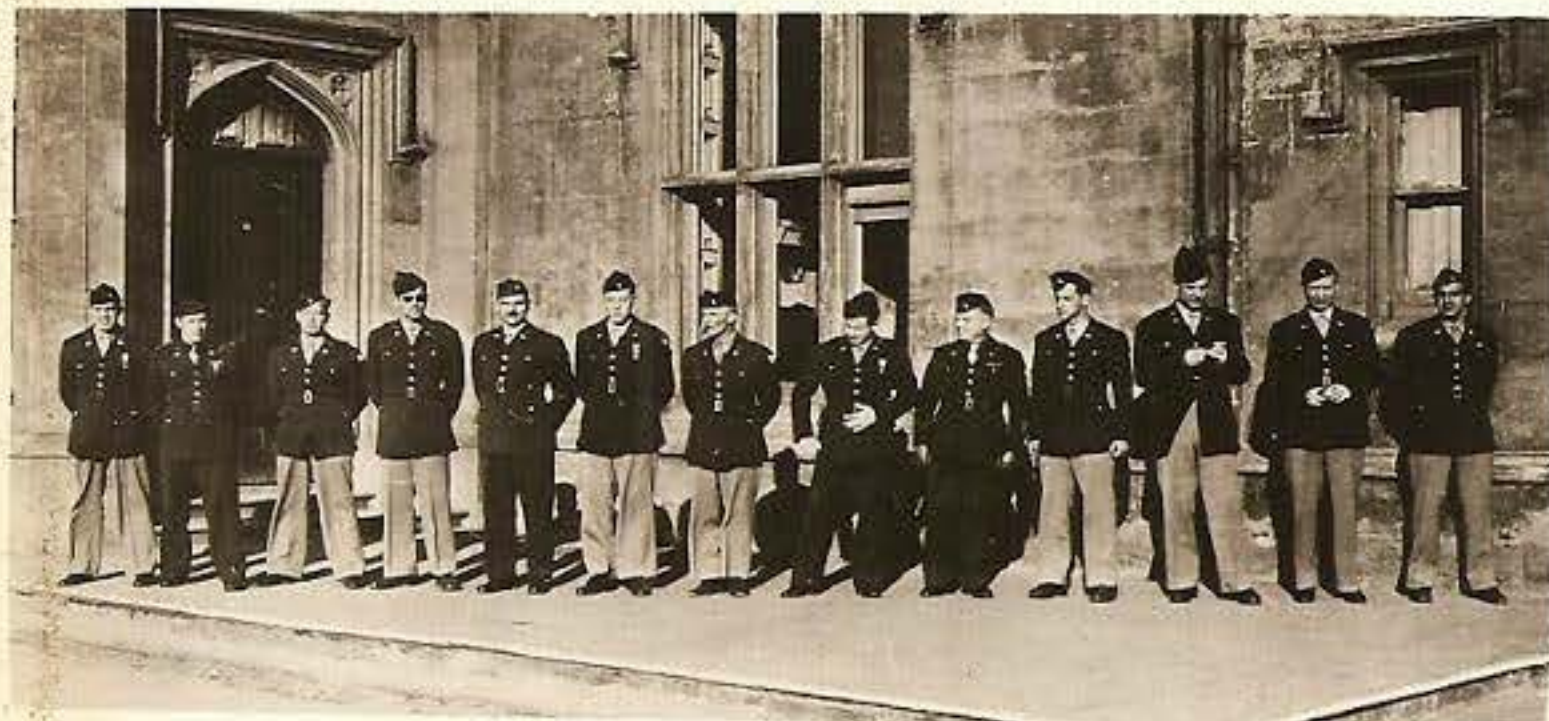

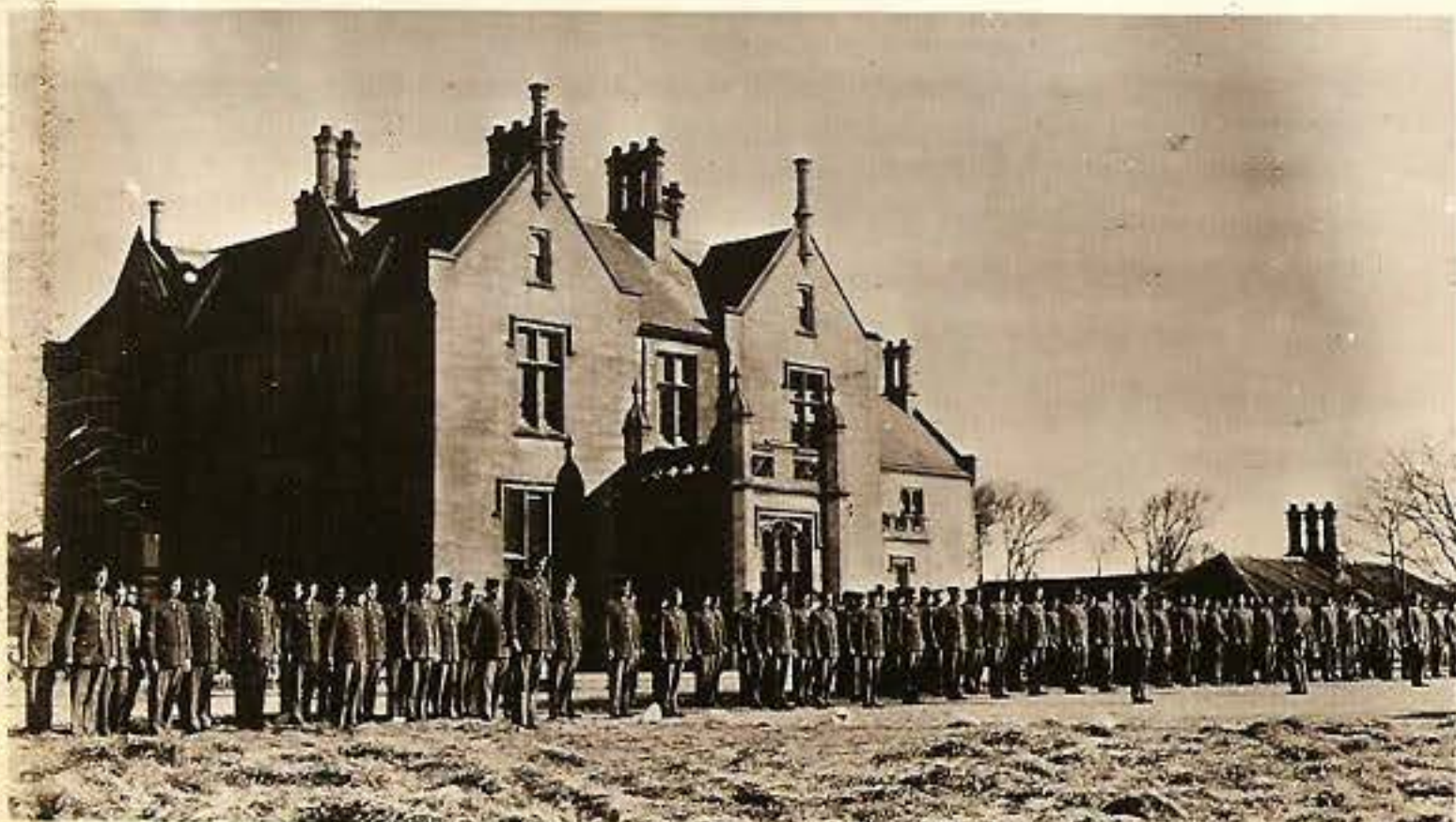
HOSTILITIES HAVE CEASED!!!

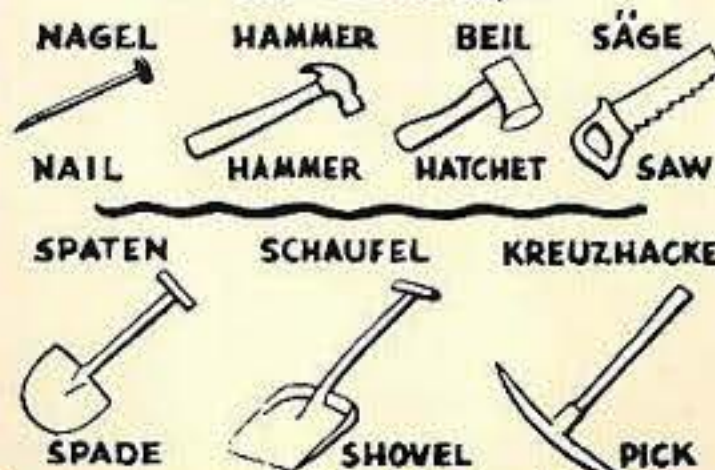
